Winners of the Best Video of 2016 at the Hotdisc Awards, Paul and Claire Bain aka Raintown are following up the very popular 19 Again with the title track from one of their albums, Writing On The Wall. Paul and Claire have recently had their first child so all is fine and dandy in their personal lives (with perhaps a little less sleep) but with new music being written these guys are in it for the long haul and have a very healthy fanbase.

This single sizzles with a great 'road' video to accompany it.

## Rich Price

We are always thrilled when acts release traditional sounding music. Rich Price is a man who, despite being in the business for a long time, makes his first Hotdisc outing with There's A Table and you can hear his influences of the likes of Roy Rogers, Gene Autry and Hank Williams in his music.

He will be known to many people as the host of Cheyenne Country, a programme currently on Sky TV's Keep It Country channel.

## Russell Lee

From Canada, Russell has recorded three albums but this is his first real venture into Europe via Hotdisc and we are thrilled to have him on board with us. His single is called Picture and as he enters his 13th year in the business since recording his first album, he has perfected his live act and is regarded as one of the top live acts in Canada. This should whet the appetite for European audiences who would love to see him over here.

## Kelly & Ellis

This exciting acoustic duo from America really know how to harmonise! Kelly & Ellis are making their debut on Hotdisc with the song, Tennessee Whiskey and I will stick my neck out and say that we are going to be hearing a lot about this duo. Leslie Ellis has appeared in high profile stage musicals but started to write her own material. She also (wait for it!) sung on Celine Dion's My Heart Will Go On from the movie Titanic which won a grammy! Casey Kelly wrote The Cowboy Rides Away for George Strait and signed to Warner Brothers. There is a very long story behind how they got together but it's well worth telling in the future.

## David Wood

David was a prolific act on Hotdisc for several years and was very successful. His traditional style of music found favour with European DJs and he charted a number of singles in the higher reaches of the Hotdisc chart. He took a break for a few years but is back and ready to once again concentrate on his music. It is a pleasure to have the big man back and his new single is We Can Make This A Better World.

The interest in Hotdisc is greater than ever with the weekly tv programme on the Keep It Country TV channel on Sky 389, FreeSat 516 and Freeview Channel 89 which gets its first airing each week on a Monday night at 6pm. It's particularly pleasing to see many British and Irish acts populating the programme which features all 20 songs within the Top 20 Hotdisc chart each week.
